BECOME A MINNESOTA LITERACY LEADER

Perks and benefits:

- Trainings and professional development opportunities
- Resources for career and financial planning
- CSA shares and cooking classes

All Literacy Leaders receive:

- Living allowance (\$472.22 bi-weekly)
- \$6,095 education award or \$1,800 stipend at end of service
- Health care benefits
- Federal student loan forbearance
- Relocation allowance (if moving 50+ miles for service)

You'll design and carry out literacy initiatives in partnership with schools and community organizations. Your work will help people gain the skills they need to share their stories, achieve their goals and succeed in school and in the workforce.

Project examples:

- Piloting a volunteer-run writer's room offering workshops and support for under-resourced high school students
- Developing a family literacy program providing ESL education to parents and children
- Creating a digital distance-learning program for adult ESL students

Eligibility:

Literacy Leaders must be:

- 18+ years old
- Able to serve full-time for one year starting in August
- A U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident, asylee, refugee or DACA recipient
- Interested in serving marginalized communities
